SCHOLARSHIP

One of JAMCCAR's objectives is to foster educational development of young people. To help fulfill this objective, JAMCCAR offers scholarships to **eligible** college bound students who will pursue full-time studies

ELIGIBILITY

- Graduating High School Seniors from any school district who are members or associate members of JAMCCAR and who have been actively participating in the organization, **or**
- Graduating High School Seniors of Jamaican parentage, graduating from a Rockland County High School and who have been actively involved in JAMCCAR or other community organizations. Proof of involvement will be required.

REQUIREMENTS

- Have at least an overall "B" average.
- Proof of acceptance to college.
- Recommendation from a teacher of the High School or a JAMCCAR member.
- An essay of at least 500 words stating educational/career goals and describing involvement in JAMCCAR and/or other community organizations.
- Personal interview with scholarship committee.
- A written statement that funds will only be used for educational purposes.
- Application **must be postmarked by April 15.**
- Completed application with attachments should be sent to JAMCCAR, Attention: Scholarship Committee, PO Box 1727, Spring Valley, NY 10977.

Please note the following points carefully:

- **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered**
- You will be notified upon receipt of application
- The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
- Awardees will be notified no later than May 31.
- Eligibility and meeting of the requirements should not be construed as a guarantee that a scholarship will be offered.
